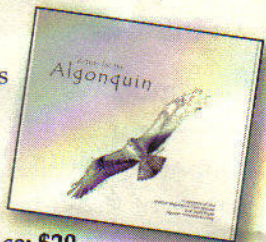


A Fabulous CD!
